Robinson Injury Law Scholarship

Graduating Utah & Arizona high school seniors who intend to study at a two or four-year college or university in Utah or Arizona are eligible to apply for a \$500 scholarship. Consideration is based on demonstration of academic achievement, financial need and an indication of the potential for success in college and beyond. Must have a GPA of 3.25 or higher to apply.

1. Deadline for the scholarship: March 13th, 2026.
2. You will be notified no later than March 31st, 2026 if you have been awarded a scholarship.
3. Application is available on our website at www.robinsoninjurylaw.com/scholarship or from a counselor at your high school.

The scholarship application & criteria are composed of these three elements:

- GPA of 3.25 (or higher);
- Typed Statement requesting scholarship (1000-2000 words / 2-4 pages);
- Supporting documentation.

PERSONAL STATEMENT REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must write a 1000-2000 word (2-4 pages) statement about the reasons the scholarship funds are needed and discuss why they feel pursuing higher education is important to them. You will be judged upon your financial need, your writing style, and any other factors you feel are important for the reviewers to know about you.

- 2) Copies of high school transcripts showing cumulative GPA (must be 3.25 or above).
